About April 9, 1865, the 2d, 3d, 10th, 15th, 18th, 20th, 26th, 30th, 32d, 37th and 45th Regiments and the 23d Battalion Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed the 4th Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry, which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1865.
